Invitation was sent to national statistics offices and statistical divisions of international organisations



Collected through survey monkey (printable version was provided to facilitate collective answer)



Survey was open from 2nd to 30th March

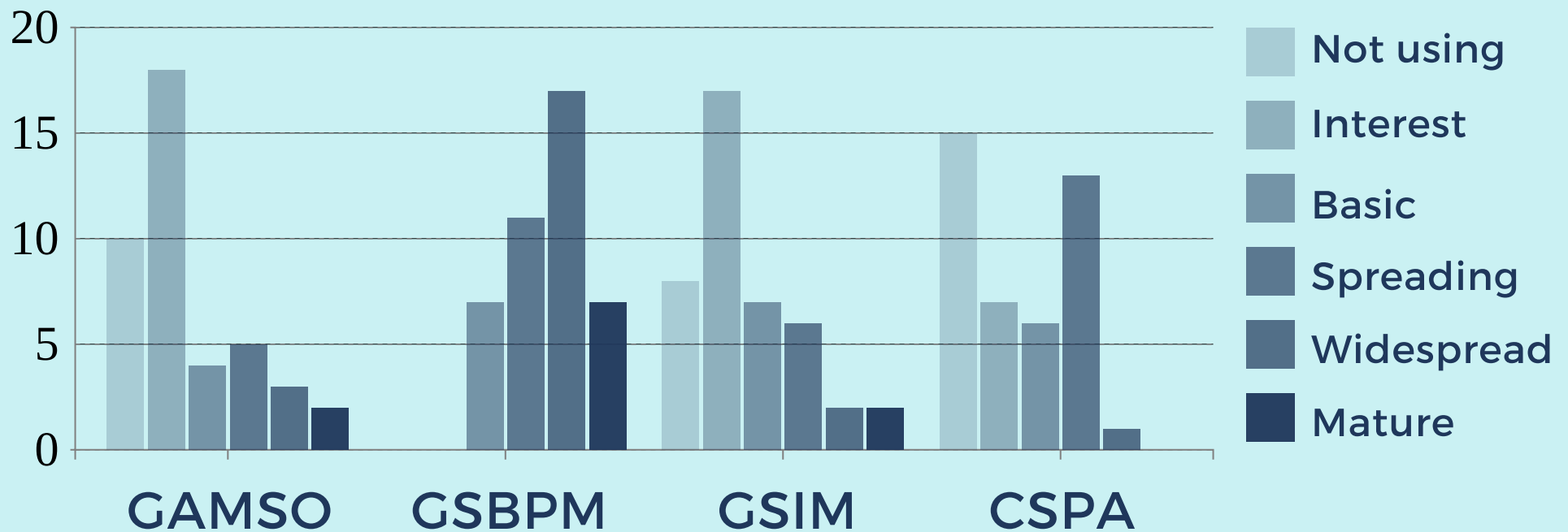

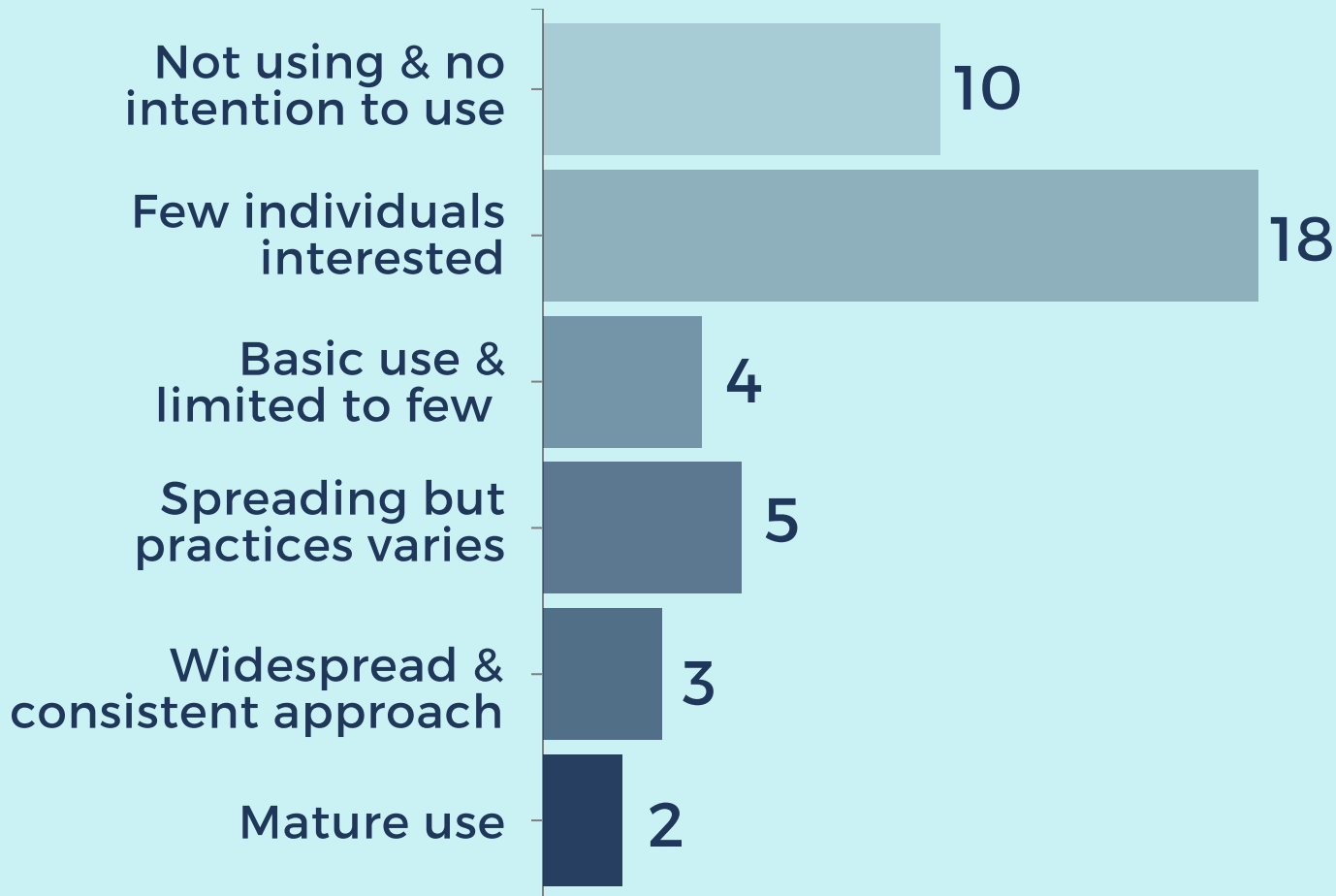

SURVEY RESULT - OVERVIEW

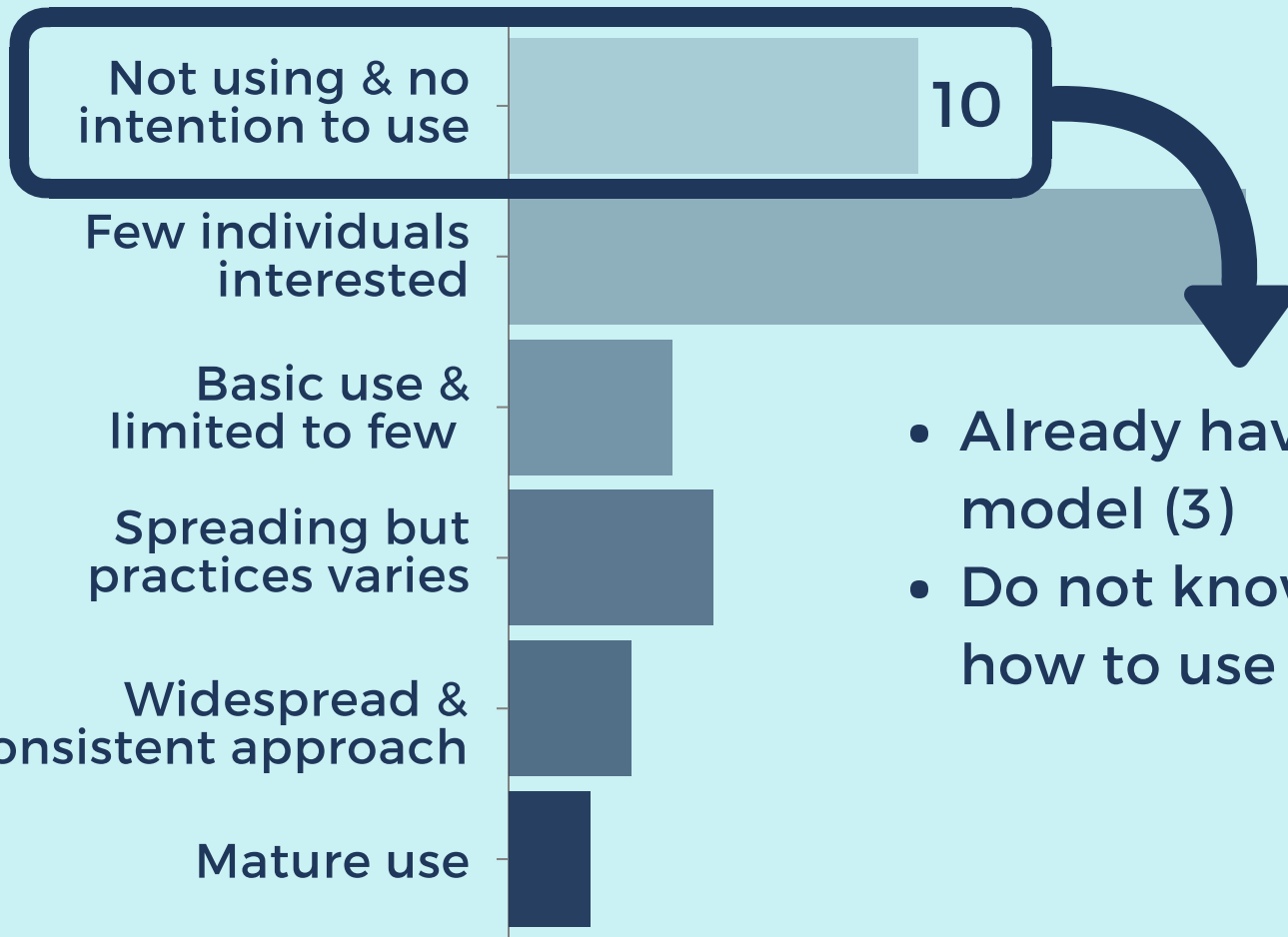
GSBPM is most widely implemented while use of GAMSO, GSIM and CSPA is more limited

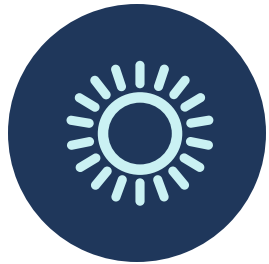

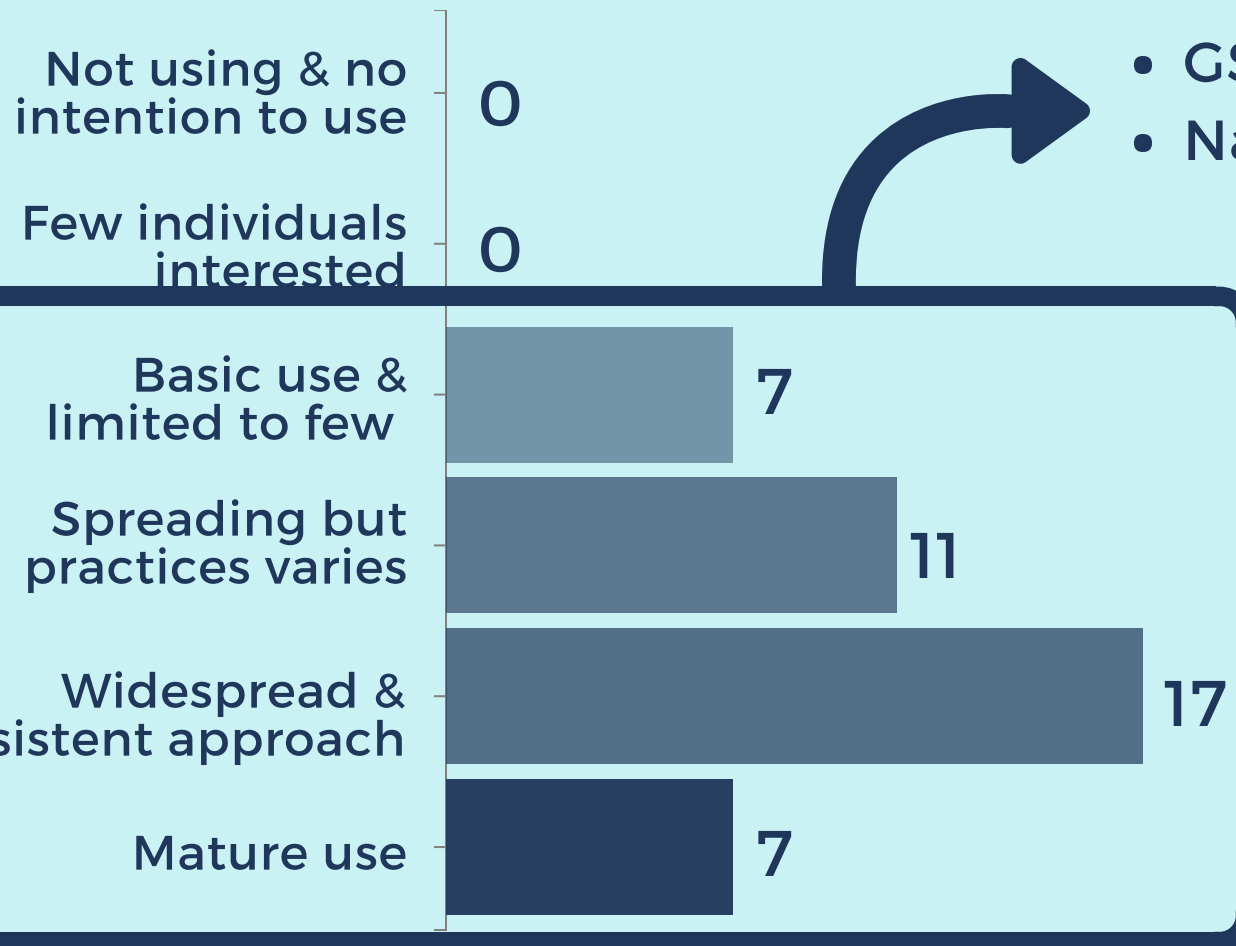

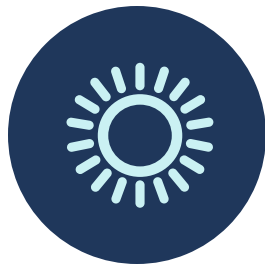

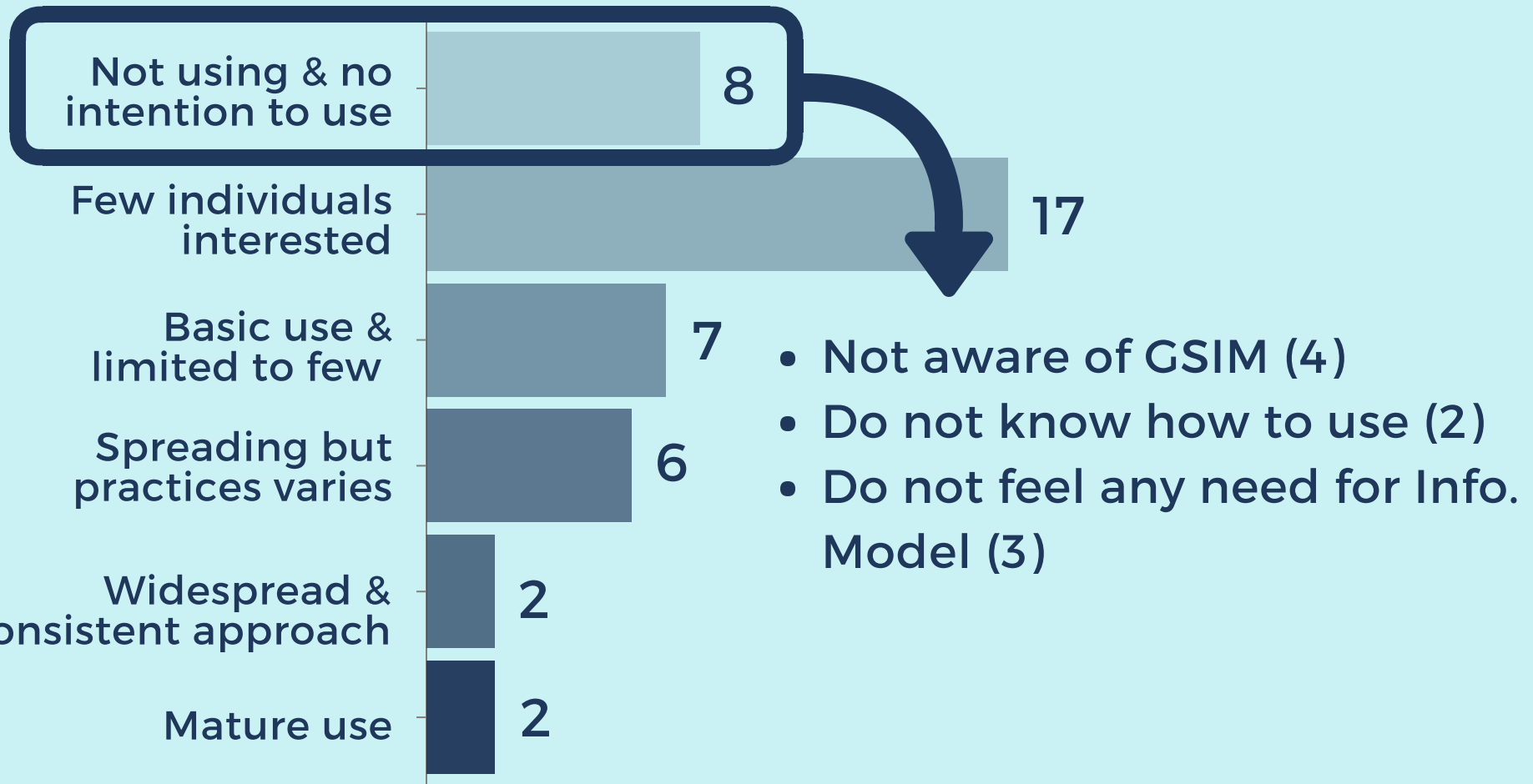
DIFFICULTY

- Others: difficulty in maintenance of national version, lack of support in non-NSI, lack of process-oriented approach among staff

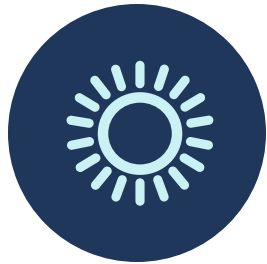

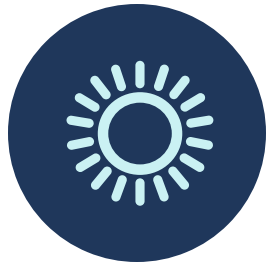
